Dear Prayer Partners,

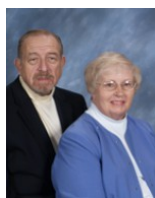

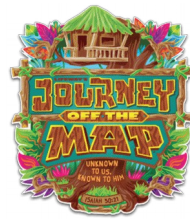
